Family Centred Service

This is a free family violence prevention service for families/whānau who have experienced, or are at risk of experiencing, family violence, and want their homes to become safe places to be. We are client led - you choose your goals and we help you achieve them.

Strengthening Families

Strengthening Families is a voluntary, client led, early intervention process which helps to improve the health, education and social outcomes for families/whānau.

Families who require support from more than one agency can get all the professionals involved to one meeting so there is one plan, and everybody is working together on the family's goals.

Pēpi-Pods

Pēpi-Pod Sleep Spaces® are offered to families of babies who are at an increased risk of accidental suffocation. The capsules provide a safe space for co-sleeping.

Home-based Family Support

This free short-term service (3-6 months) provides advice and support to parents/caregivers with children aged up to 17 years. We teach parenting skills, household management and routines; we work to increase the parent's knowledge of their children's needs and offer support to manage children's behaviour. The Triple P evidence-based parenting programme may be offered within this service. We provide advocacy and/or referrals to other agencies as required. We are client led - you choose your goals and we help you achieve them.

Family Start

Family Start is a home visiting programme that focuses on improving children's growth and health, learning and relationships, family circumstances, environment and safety. It helps whānau who are struggling with challenges or problems that may make it harder for them to care for their baby or young child.

Restorative Justice

Restorative Justice is a process which aims to put right harm done to victims by offenders. Facilitators provide a safe and positive environment where offender and victim can meet face to face.
